The first step is to reach out. Contact me any way you can. Email, text, phone call, social media, or my inquiry page on my website. We will book a "Discovery Call" where we chat on the phone and we both ask questions to get a better understanding of each other.

We will then set up a time for a free home consultation where I can see the space for myself. During the home consultation you can show me around your house so I can get a feel for your style.
