The Accelerated Degree Program

Our Accelerated Degree Program offers five, eight-week modules throughout the year. By taking two classes during all five modules, students earn 30 credits in a year, and can complete their associate's degree in two years, their bachelor's degree in four years and their graduate degree in 18 months or less. Students who have transfer credits or take more than two classes each module may complete their degree in even less time.
